

## **Theatre in a Mobile App**



Henry G20 is a bold retelling of the conflict between police and protestors during the G20 Summit in Toronto in June 2010 that led to the largest mass arrest in Canadian history. Freely adapted from Shakespeare's Henry V, writers Christine Brubaker and Constantine X. Anastaskis tell the story of Henry, a headstrong grassroots activist who makes her mark on history.



The Henry G20 Mobile App is a custom digital storytelling tool, available through iOS and Android app stores. The app contains a seven-episode audio drama and seven augmented reality experiences activated by a series of posters. Audiences download the app onto their personal mobile devices for a custom *Henry G20* experience.







# Christine Brubaker, Writer/Director Christine is a director, actor, writer currently based in Calgary where she teaches directing and acting in the School of Creative and Performing Arts at the University of Calgary. Christine has worked on Canadian stages for the past 24 years winning two Dora Mavor Moore Awards, the Gina Wilkinson Prize and the 2016 Ken McDougall Award for Direction. She specializes in new work and adaptation and activating new platforms for performance.

## **Audio and Augmented Reality**

The Henry G20 App combines an audio player and customized augmented reality experiences that transport audience members to Toronto, Canada in June 2010, through their personal mobile device and headphones. First, users listen to the prologue of the audio drama. Second, users watch an augmented reality tutorial to learn about the features utilized in the app. Finally, users can select any button on the home screen map to toggle between listening to the 6 audio drama episodes and viewing the 7 augmented reality experiences. The entire experience takes 1 hour and 45 minutes.


## A Series of 7 Posters Embedded in a City



After downloading the app, audience members are invited to listen to the audio drama episodes while walking along a predetermined route between poster installation sites. Each poster activates one of the augmented reality scenes.
